Sport Positive Summit Postponed Until October in Light of Coronavirus

3 March, London – In light of the recently global outbreak of the novel Coronavirus COVID-19, Sport Positive Summit organisers have taken the decision to postpone the Summit until October 1-2 2020.

In collaboration with UNFCCC Global Climate Action and International Olympic Committee, Sport Positive Summit 2020 is the global meeting place for sports organisations effecting, or looking to effect, positive environmental impacts. The postponed Summit will still take place at Wembley Stadium, connected by EE, on the new October dates.

Founder and CEO of Sport Positive, Claire Poole, said of the decision, “The health and wellbeing of our community is of paramount importance and our number one priority. Taking into account the justified concerns of our participants, who will join us from 22+ countries, we have made the difficult decision to postpone the Summit.”

She went on to say “Our speakers, partners, collaborators and attendees have been unequivocally supportive of this move, and we will continue to work tirelessly to drive momentum around this important issue through to our new dates in October, and beyond.”
